Dear players and parents,

Congratulations; you have signed for Swords Celtic for the 2009/2010 season and I hope you have a happy and successful season. The following are the conditions on which schoolboy players are signed by the club and other important information.

SUBSCRIPTIONS. At the recent A.G.M. it was decided that subs. would remain the same as last year – €150 yearly sub to be paid in by the end of Sept **or** two payments of €80, one in September and one in January 2010. If you have two children playing for the club the cost is €250 per year or €125 twice yearly (Sept and Jan). Additional children are free. If you have a difficulty with the payment of subs please talk to me or Carolyn in confidence.

GEAR: All players are expected to wear the club shorts and socks. These are available to purchase in the club shop.

INSURANCE / INJURIES: Swords Celtic FC has full public liability insurance – however this does not cover medical costs for injuries occurred at training or during matches. Many parents pay school insurance which generally covers your child for medical expenses twenty-four/seven (please check your child's school about this). The club may refund €50 towards the cost of a visit to A/E or the VHI clinic in the case of emergencies.

TRAINING AND MATCH DAYS Managers and coaches are involved in the club on a voluntary basis and give considerable time and effort and personal expense. Please give the manager plenty of advance notice if your child is not available for a match or cannot attend training. If you are unsure if a match is going ahead (e.g. bad weather) please ring your manager to confirm. (Remember you just have to make one phone call, the manager may have to make 20).

The facilities in the clubhouse (including free tea/coffee) are available to parents on match days and most training nights.
